
LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Arizona Parks and Recreation Association

This award honors professionals, now retired, who led the way; who strove for standards, professionalism and recognition for their field of service; and who dedicated themselves to quality park and recreation services for all. Must be a past or present member of APRA and NRPA, have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in study, have at least **fifteen years' experience** in the general field of parks, recreation, and conservation in Arizona and the Pacific Southwest Region; and have contributed to the general field of parks and recreation beyond scope of job. Selected nominees will be awarded a Lifetime Association Membership. The candidate must score a minimum of 70 points to qualify.

| 10 | Served as an elected or appointed member of APRA or NRPA board of directors |
| 10 | Served as a chair of an APRA committee, TEAMS (branch), or work group. |
| 5 | Currently serves on a committee or board of directors. |
| 15 | Outstanding leadership to parks and recreation staff and/or students. Mentorship, teaching, presenting, training development, etc. |
| 25 | Outstanding or unusual contributions to the profession of park, recreation, or related field. |
| 15 | Continues to volunteer for agencies/programs that benefit parks and recreation. |
| 10 | Author or co-author of a book, magazine articles, research on parks, recreation, or conservation. |
| 10 | Up to two pages of supplemental materials (8 1/2 x 11) may be submitted; supplemental pages are defined as news articles, photos, drawings, etc. which enhance understanding of the project. All supplemental information must be submitted in PDF Format. |
